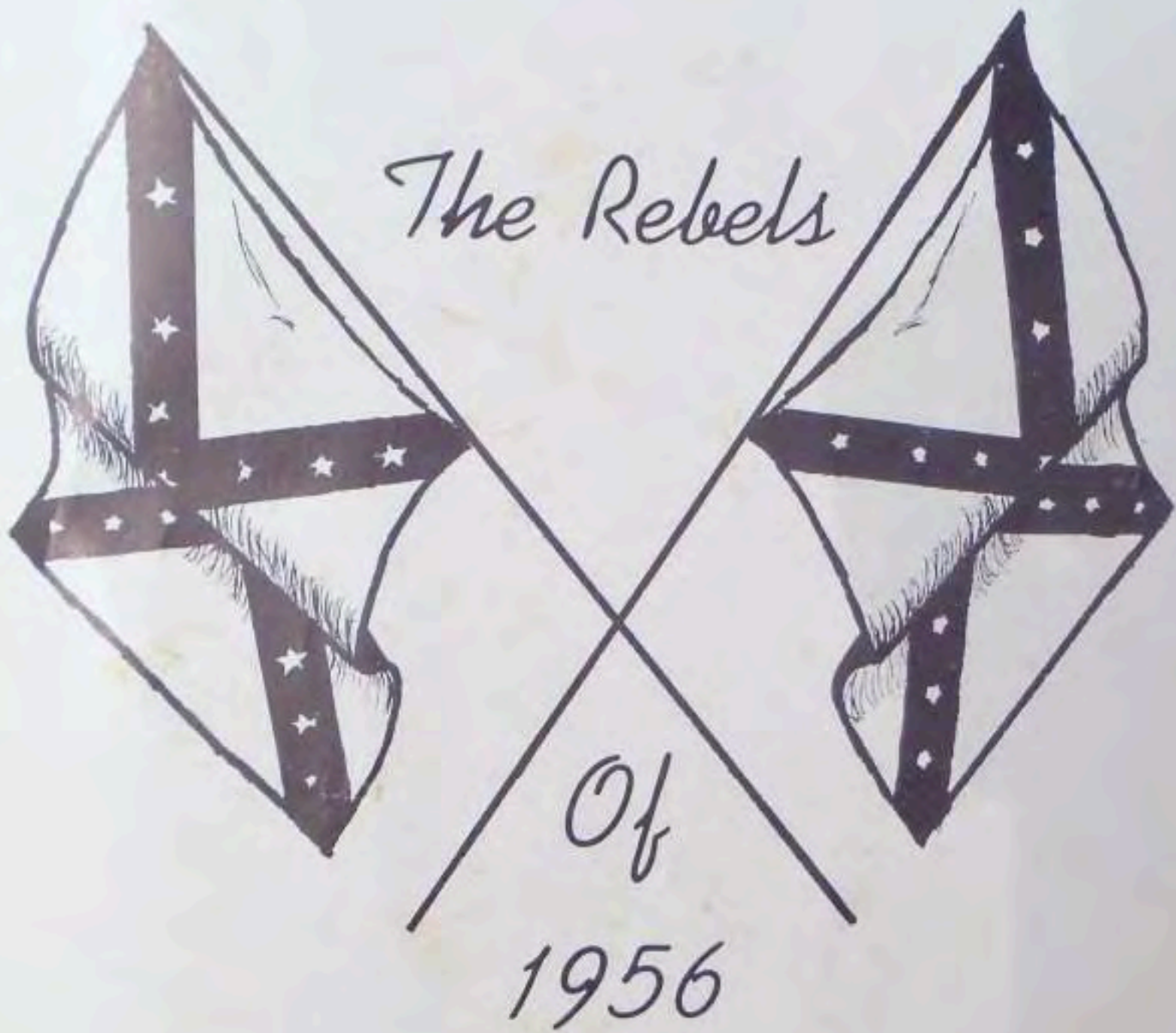

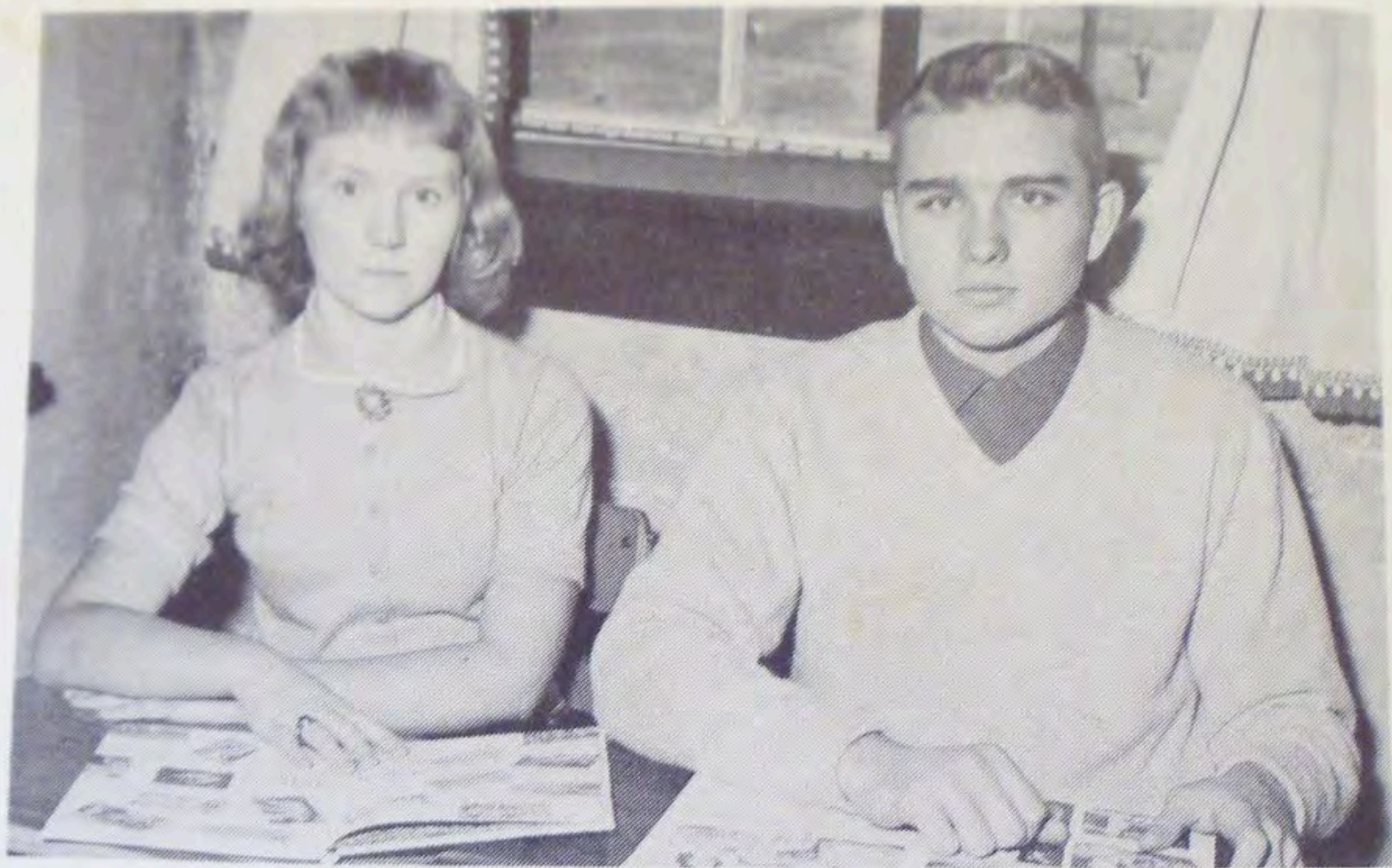

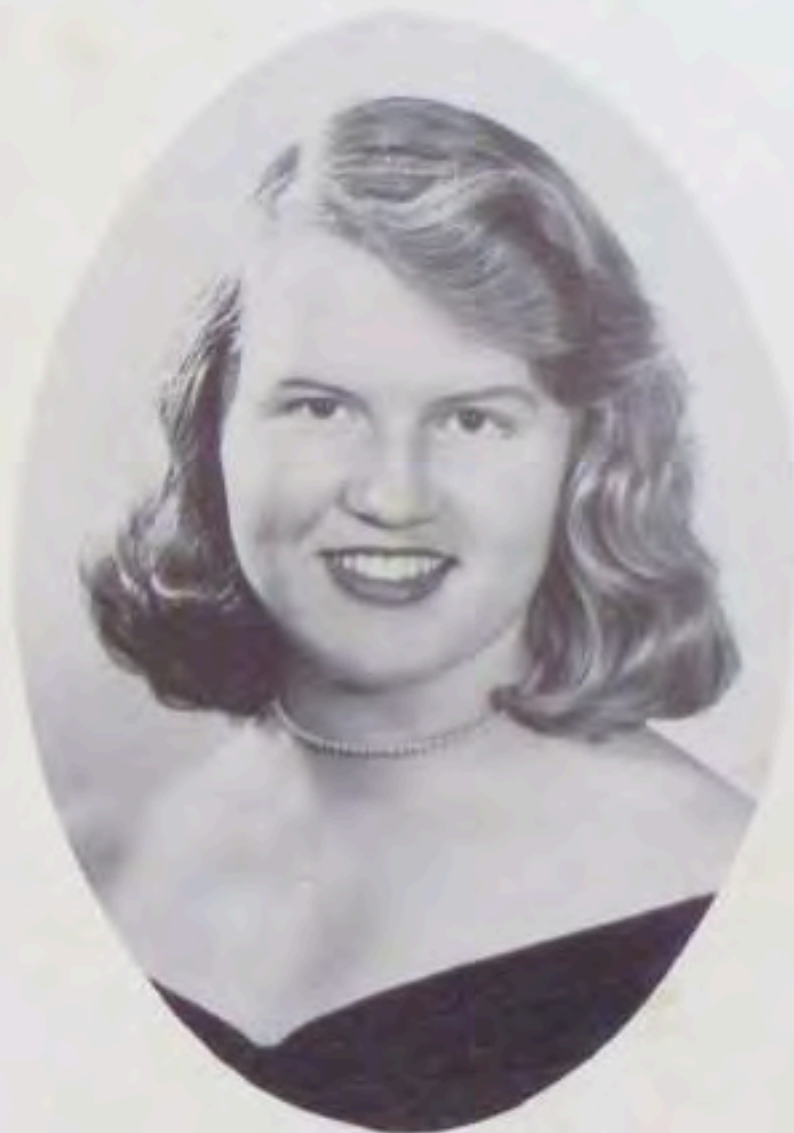

Class History

The marshals, the four students with the highest scholastic standings, were: Marjorie Pridgen, Rachel Davis, Ada Margaret Barfield, and Ed Lewis, Jr.

An idea which began to evolve several years ago became a reality.
