LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

State of North Carolina
County of Duplin
Townships of Faison and Wolfsrape

We, the Senior Class of North Duplin High School in the year of our Lord, Nineteen Hundred and Fifty-Eight, being of sound mind and realizing that our impending departure from the school is close at hand, do hereby declare and make this our last will and testament.

ARTICLE I
