And we'll win over all.

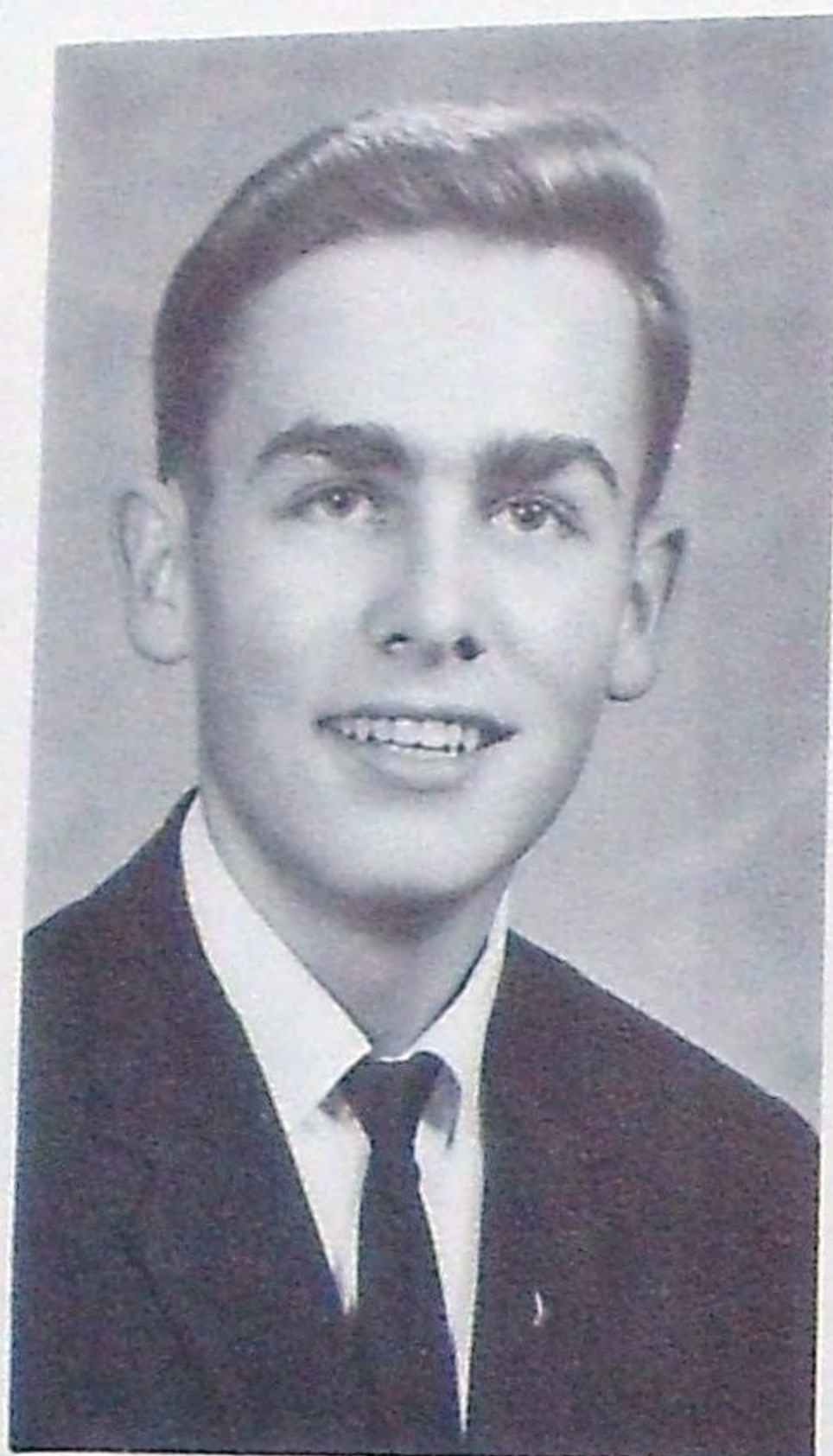
